Rainbow Community School Financial Aid Procedures and Timeline for 2016-2017

A limited amount of financial aid is available for families with demonstrated need and who would not otherwise be able to send their child to Rainbow Community School. The steps for all families are below, with deadlines for re-enrolling families. For new families, the enrollment process and the application for financial aid are completed in tandem, by following the steps below as soon as possible.

February 2: Re-enrollment contracts sent to parents.

February 19: Re-enrollment contracts due for enrolled students. Current financial aid recipients must submit a contract to qualify for financial aid. RCS requires re-enrolling and new financial aid applicants to pay the annual Enrollment Fee of \$275 at this time.

March 9: Deadline for Financial Aid Application to be completed online at <u>www.mytads.com</u>. There is a \$34 application fee. This form should be filled out using income figures from a completed 2015 tax return (or your best estimate if your taxes have not yet been filed). Also due is the RCS Financial Aid Application. A copy is enclosed; please complete and return to the school office by March 9.

If current families have an overdue balance, they must pay their balance before receiving a grant for the following year.

Early to Mid April: Review of applications by the Financial Aid Committee and notification of financial aid grant emailed to families.

April 15: This is the last day to withdraw your contract for the 2016-17 school year. If your financial aid award is not sufficient for your child to attend RCS and you withdraw your contract *by this date,* you will receive a full refund for the paid \$275 Enrollment Fee, *provided you request this refund in writing.* (This exception is *only* made for financial aid applicants.)

If it is later than April, you should still apply

Generally all - or almost all - of the assistance will be awarded in April. However, when possible, the committee tries to keep a small amount for new families and/or for families who have a financial crisis during the school year. Also, if a child of a family who accepted a financial aid award is unable to attend RCS, their award amount becomes available to other applicants.

FYI: Some Factors Considered by the Financial Aid Committee

RCS is a small private school that has a very limited amount of financial aid. Aid is largely provided by the generosity of RCS families, who contribute to the Rainbow Community School Annual Campaign. The financial aid decision is very complex. We consider a multitude of factors, some of which are unique to particular families.

Below are examples of some factors considered by the Financial Aid Committee:

Family Resources: Assets and discretionary spending

<u>Diversity</u>: One of the purposes of financial aid is to increase the economic diversity and other forms of diversity on campus. We are an affirmative action school.

<u>Class</u>: Size and available spots, including class balance factors. These factors include gender (number of boys and girls in each class), percent of special needs students in each classroom, and racial balance.

<u>Non-Working Parent</u>: If a parent makes the decision not to work after the youngest child enters Kindergarten, RCS will calculate a potential income for the non-working parent, and calculate that into the possible tuition contribution the family can make.

<u>Divorced and Separated Parents</u>: In the case of a divorce or separation, the school requires both parents to file an application for financial aid. We believe it is unfair for RCS to subsidize a child's education if one of the parents is capable, but unwilling, to contribute to his/her child's tuition. Contact the business office for guidance in handling unusual circumstances.

<u>Payment History</u>: The Tuition and Fees section of the RCS Parent Handbook states that all parents must pay any outstanding balance before their child can be enrolled for the upcoming school year. Current financial aid recipients must also have a zero balance to receive an award for their child's enrollment for the next year. The Financial Aid Committee also takes into consideration the payment history of current financial aid recipients.
