

This class will introduce students to the Makey Makey, an interface between computers and real world objects! The Makey Makey is a remarkably easy to use and easy to understand tool that has been designed to unlock students' creativity when thinking about unique ways to interact with a computer. The concept is very straightforward: Complete an electrical circuit using your own body as a conductor, and the Makey

Makey responds by sending a keystroke to any connected computer. By using that one core idea,

students will have the opportunity to create electronic instruments, video game controllers, and more. Throughout this class we will take a hands-on, project based approach to exploring how electricity behaves and how we can use it to interact with computers in creative new ways.







Nicholas Rake has lived in Asheville for 13 years and is a self-taught programmer and electronics tinkerer. He has been a part of Asheville Makers for four years, organizing the group's educational outreach program and has taught coding classes at Rainbow, started an after-school coding club at Odyssey and led an all-ages Arduino Bootcamp through the Asheville Museum of Science. 
