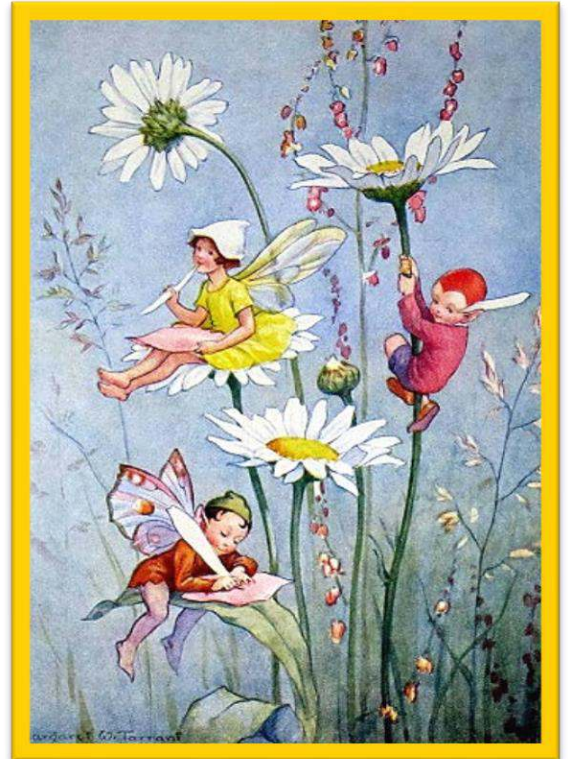

Omega Writing Club!

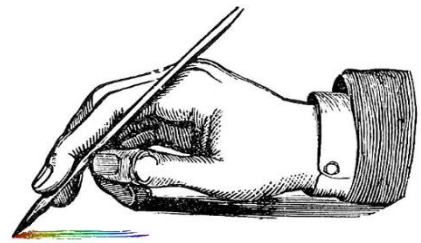

Recently, when bowling with Nik and Emmie, her

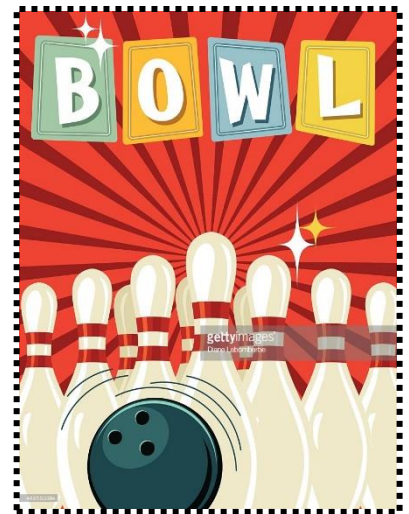
children, Nik thought it would be pretty radical if we
